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Difficulty: **

The finished project with the proposed materials is 27 cm high.

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Stitches & Abbreviations:

MR – Magic ring

Ch – Chain

Slst – slipstitch

Sc – single crochet

Esc– extended single crochet - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tKXbjs0Xen4>

Hdc – half double crochet

Dc – double crochet

Sc2 in 1 – 2 single crochet in one stitch

Dc2 in 1 – 2 double crochet in one stitch

Dc3 in 1 – 3 double crochet in one stitch

Sc2tog- single crochet 2 stitches together

Dc2tog – double crochet 2 stitches together

PC – popcornstitch - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wq0qCBusKHk>

Turn

Rnd(s) – round(s)

..... repeat (rep) wat is in between the **

(..) at the end of the round or row indicates the amount of stitches after that round or row.

Note: The pattern is crochet completely with crochet hook size 2 mm, unless stated otherwise.

It is important that you follow the order of the pattern.

Arm 2x:

Using **colornr 508.**

Rnd 01: MR with 6sc	(6)
Rnd 02: sc2 in each stitch	(12)
Rnd 03: sc in each stitch	(12)
Rnd 04: 4 sc, (sc2 in 1) x 2, 4 sc, (sc2 in 1) x 2	(16)
Rnd 05: 4 sc, sc2 in 1, 2 sc, sc2 in 1, 4 sc, sc2 in 1, 2 sc, sc2 in 1	(20)

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Rnd 06: 4 sc, sc2 in 1, 2 sc, 1PC, sc, sc2 in 1, 4 sc, sc2 in 1, 4 sc, sc2 in 1 (24)

Rnd 07: 4 sc, sc2tog, sc, sc2tog, sc, sc2tog, 4 sc, sc2tog, sc, sc2tog, sc, sc2tog (18)

Rnd 08: Sc in each stitch (18)

Rnd 09: *4 sc, sc2tog* x 3 (15)

Rnd 10: Sc in each stitch (15)

Rnd 11: *3 sc, sc2tog* x 3, change to **skincolor** in the last stitch (12)

Fasten off purple.

Rnd 12: Back loop only, Sc in each stitch (12)

Rnd 13 – 15: Sc in each stitch (12)

Take a pipe cleaner and fold a loop at the bottom about the size of the hand (see photo). Put some tape around the pointed ends.



We first crochet the softy edge with 2.5 mm crochet hook before putting the pipe cleaner in the hand.

- Hand away from you, attach with softy and sc in the 1st free loop, sc in each loop (12)

Fasten off.



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Place the loop parallel with the thumb in the hand (the thumb in row 6 points to the front) and stuff the hand in moderately. Also stuff the arm in moderately while crocheting.

Rnd 16 – 24: Sc in each stitch (12)

1 slst and **fasten off**. Hide all loose end. **This is your left arm! Cut the pipe cleaner to 1 cm above the arm. Put some tape around the end.**



Work a 2nd arm up to round 24. Then work 2 sc and 1 slst and **fasten off!** Now count 5 stitches ahead on this arm and place a mark on it. This will be your first stitch to attach the right arm.

Dress:

Using **colornr 508**

We are going to set up with double crochet. For those who do not know how to do this, view this link. Wendy Rademaker explains it very well.

The chainstitches do NOT count as the first double crochet!! Begin every round in the closing stitch!

Rnd 01: crochet 50 dc. **Change to colornr 106** and close rnd with slst in the 1st dc (50)

Rnd 02: Back loop only, ch3 (does NOT count as 1^e dc), dc2 in the same stitch, Dc3 in 1, *Dc2 in 1, Dc3 in 1* rep ** to end, close rnd with slst in the 1st dc (125)

Rnd 03 - 12: Ch 3, Dc in each stitch, close rnd with slst in the 1st dc (125)

Rnd 13: Ch 3, Dc in each stitch, **change to colornr 520**, close rnd with slst in the 1st dc (125)

Fasten off white.

Rnd 14: Back loop only, Ch 1, sc in each stitch, close rnd with slst in the 1st stitch (125)

Rnd 15: Ch 1, Sc in each stitch, close rnd with slst in the 1st stitch (125)

Rnd 16: Ch 3, Dc, *skip 1 stitch, Dc, Dc in the skipped stitch* x 62, close rnd with slst in the 1st dc (125)

Rnd 17: Ch 1, Sc in each stitch, close rnd with slst in the 1st stitch (125)

Rnd 18: Ch 1, Sc in each stitch, **change to colornr 106**, close rnd with slst in the 1st stitch (125)

Fasten off colornr 520.

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Rnd 19: Back loop only, Ch 1, Sc in each stitch, close rnd with slst in the 1st stitch (125)

Rnd 20: Ch 1, Sc in each stitch, close rnd with slst in the 1st stitch (125)

Rnd 21: Ch 1, Sc in each stitch, **change to colornr 508**, close rnd with slst in the 1st stitch (125)

Fasten off white.


Rnd 22: Ch 1, Sc in each stitch, close rnd with slst in the 1st stitch (125)

Rnd 23: Ch 3, Dc, *skip 1 stitch, Dc, Dc in the skipped stitch* x 62, close rnd with slst in the 1st dc (125)

Rnd 24: Ch 1, Sc in each stitch, **change to Softy**, close rnd with slst in the 1st stitch (125)

Rnd 25: using crochet hook 2.5 mm, Ch 1, Sc in each stitch, **fasten off.** (125)

- **With the Softy edge away from you**, attach with slst and **colornr 106** in the 1st remaining loop of round 14 (photo 1), Ch 1, * slst, Ch 1 * rep ** all around. Close with slst in the 1st stitch. **Fasten off.**
- **With the Softy edge towards you**, attach with slst and **colornr 520** in the 1st remaining loop of round 19 (photo 2), Ch 1, * slst, Ch 1 * rep ** all around. Close with slst in the 1st stitch. **Fasten off.**
