• Additional colors: 1. White colornr 106 – 50 gr

2. Delphinium (dark purple) - colornr 113 - 50 gr

3. Light orchid (light purple) colornr 226 - 50 gr

4. Garden rose (medio purple) colornr 251 - 50 gr

**Note:** if you take white as the maincolor, **DO NOT** take white as the additional color!!!!

Hooksize 2.5 mm - 2.00 mm

2 safety eyes 15 mm (color of choise) i used blue

1 black triangular safety nose 2 cm

Fiberfill (stuffing)

Needle

**Pipecleaners** 

3 buttons 13 mm

2 small flowers or any other decoration max 2 cm tall

Piece of cardboard

# **Stitches and Abbreviations:** US terminology

MR - Magic ring

Ch - Chain

Chst - chain stitch

Slst – slip stitch

Sc – single crochet

Hdc - half double crochet

Dc – double crochet

Trc – triple crochet

Rsc – reverse single crochet

Sc2 in 1-2 single crochet in 1 stitch - increase

Dc2 in 1 – 2 double crochet in 1 stitch – increase

Dc3 in 1 – 3 double crochet in 1 stitch - increase

Sc2tog - single crochet 2 together - decrease

Dc2tog - double crochet 2 together - decrease

Turn

# Arms 2x:

Using colornr 172. Cut a piece of thread of 1 m. Keep it aside.

Rnd 02: sc2 in each stitch

(12)

**Rnd 10:** sc in next 5 st, (sc2tog) x 2, sc in next 6 st, (sc2tog) x 2, sc (16)

Stuff the hand slightly untill round 6. Let's create the fingers first.

Make sure the decreases are on the side;

Take the grey thread, with the mark at the right side, put in the needle just above round 5 and in the middle of the hand (photo 1) leaving 5cm of thread, and come out on the other side in the middle of the hand, just above round 6 (photo 2), go over the magic ring and stick the needle back in the same place as you started, come out at the same place above round 6. Pull thread firmly. Repeat one more time. Pull thread out of the needle and go over the magic ring and make a knot with both ends. (photo 3). Cut the ends, leaving 3 cm, so you can hide loose ends later.



Count 2 stitches to the right, \*\* put in the needle just above round 5, leaving 5 cm of thread, and come out on the other side, just above round 6 and also 2 stitches further, go over the front and go back in where you started. Come out at the same place above round 6. Pull thread firmly. Repeat one more time. Repeat one more time. Pull thread out of the needle and go over the magic ring and make a knot with both ends. Cut the ends, leaving 3 cm, so you can hide loose ends later.\*\*

Now count 2 stitches to the left and repeat what is between the \*\*



**Backside** 

Frontside

Hide all loose ends as soon as the arm is finished.

#### Continue with the arm.

Take a pipecleaner and fold it double. Wrap some tape around the ends.

Place the loop in the hand on the inside (this is where the knots are). Stuff the arm slightly. You can now bend the arm when it's finished.

Slst in next 2 stitches and FO. Hide all loose ends.



## Ears 2x:

Using colornr 172

Rnd 01: MR sc8 (8

Rnd 02: sc2 in each stitch (16)

**Rnd 03 – 05:** sc in each stitch (16)

**Rnd 06:** \*sc2 in 1\* x 2, sc in next 14 st (18)

**Rnd 07:** sc, \*sc2 in 1\* x 2, sc in next 15 st **(20)** 

Rnd 08: sc in each stitch (20)

**Rnd 09:** sc in next 2 st, \*sc2 in 1\* x 2, sc in next 16 st (22)

**Rnd 10:** sc in next 3 st, \*sc2 in 1\* x 2, sc in next 10 st, \*sc2 in 1\* x 2, sc in next 5 st **(26)** 

Rnd 11: sc in next 4 st, \*sc2 in 1\* x 2, sc in next 12 st, \*sc2 in 1\* x 2, sc in next 6 st (30)

Rnd 12 - 18: sc in each stitch (30)

**Rnd 19:** sc in next 6 st, \*sc2tog\* x 2, sc in next 12 st, sc2tog, sc in next 6 st (27)

**Rnd 20:** sc in next 6 st, sc2tog, sc in next 19 st (26)

**Rnd 21:** sc in next 5 st, \*sc2tog\* x 2, sc in next 10 st, sc2tog, sc in next 5 st **(23)** 

**Rnd 22:** sc in next 4 st, \*sc2tog\* x 2, sc in next 15 st (21)

Rnd 23: sc in next 3 st, \*sc2tog\* x 2, sc in next 8 st, sc2tog, sc in next 4 st (18)

Rnd 24: sc in each stitch (18)

**Rnd 25:** sc in next 3 st, sc2tog, sc in next 8 st, sc2tog, sc in next 3 st (16)

**Rnd 26 – 27:** sc in each stitch (16)

**Rnd 28:** sc in next 5 st, you're on the corner now, puch the two sides against eachother en close with 8 sc FO leaving long tail to sew the ears.



# Cheeks 2x:

Using colornr 172.

**Rnd 01:** MR sc6 (6)

Rnd 02: sc2 in each stitch

(12)

Rnd 03: \*sc, sc2 in 1\* x 6

(18)

**Rnd 04:** \*sc in next 2 st, sc2 in 1\* x 6 (24)

**Rnd 05 - 06:** sc in each stitch (24)

Rnd 07: \*sc in next 4 st, sc2tog\* x 4 (18)

FO. Do not stuff.



## Mouth:

Using colornr 172.

Rnd 01: Ch4, start in the second ch from the hook, sc1, sc3 in 1, contnue on the other side of the chain, sc, sc2 in 1

(8)

Rnd 02: sc in each stitch (8)

Fold in the lenght, so the good side is on the outside. Close with 4 slst. Sew a few stitches with the dark pink thread inside the mouth. It looks like it has a tongue. **NOTICE! Only sew in the top layer!!** 



# **Head:**

Using colornr 172

Rnd 01: MR sc6

Rnd 02: sc2 in each stitch

(12)

**Rnd 03:** \*sc, sc2 in 1\* x 6

(18)

**Rnd 04:** \*sc in next 2 st, sc2 in 1\* x 6 (24)

**Rnd 05:** \*sc in next 3 st, sc2 in 1\* x 6 (30)

**Rnd 06:** \*sc in next 4 st, sc2 in 1\* x 6 (36)

**Rnd 07:** \*sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1\* x 6 (42)

**Rnd 08:** \*sc in next 6 st, sc2 in 1\* x 6 (48)

**Rnd 09:** \*sc in next 7 st, sc2 in 1\* x 6 (54)

**Rnd 10:** \*sc in next 8 st, sc2 in 1\* x 6 (60)

**Rnd 11:** \*sc in next 9 st, sc2 in 1\* x 6 (66)

**Rnd 12 – 15:** sc in each stitch (66)

In next round we're going to crochet the cheeks on to the head.

Rnd 16: sc in next 22 st, take a cheek and push the it together, push the hook through both layers (one stitch on each layer) AND the next stitch on the head (see photo), sc1, make another 2sc in the same stitch, continue with the next 9 stitches the same way, (in total you have made 30 sc over 10 stitches to attach the cheeks on to the head), sc1, CH1 (this is for the nose later), skip one stitch, sc1, take the second cheek and attach it the same way as the first one, (again 30 sc over 10 stitches), sc in next 21 st (106)



Attaching the cheak

Rnd 17: sc in each stitch (106)

Rnd 18: sc in next 48 st, \*sc2tog\* x 2, sc in next 3 st, \*sc2tog\* x 2, sc in next 47 st (102)

**Rnd 19:** sc in next 22 st, \*sc2tog\* x 3, sc in next 16 st, \*sc2tog\* x 3, sc in next 3 st, \*sc2tog\* x 3, sc in next 16 st, \*sc2tog\* x 3, sc in next 21st (90)

Rnd 20: sc in next 22 st, \*sc2tog\* x 4, sc in next 8 st, \*sc2tog\* x 3, sc in next 3 st, \*sc2tog\* x 3, sc in next 8 st, \*sc2tog\* x 4, sc in next 21 st

(76)

**Rnd 21:** sc2tog, sc in next 18 st, sc2tog, sc in next 3 st, \*sc2tog\* x 5, sc in next 7 st, \*sc2tog\* x 5, sc in next 3 st, sc2tog, sc in next 17 st, sc2tog

(62)

**Rnd 22:** sc in next 18 st, sc2tog, sc in next 24 st, sc2tog, sc in next 16 st (60)

**Rnd 23:** \*sc in next 8 st, sc2tog\* x 6 (54)

**Rnd 24:** \*sc in next 7 st, sc2tog\* x 6 (48)

**Rnd 25:** \*sc in next 6 st, sc2tog\* x 6 (42)

Put the nose in the small chain-opening of round 16. Put the safety cap on it. Put the eyes 3 rounds above the nose and on the beginning of the cheeks, leaving 5 stitches between the eyes. (see photo below). Stuff the head firmly, especially around the cheeks.

Stuff head firmly..

FO, wave the thread trough the front loops and pull tight. Hide all loose ends.

Sew the mouth in the middle between the cheeks, 1 round below the nose..

Sew the ears on to the head. The big round is pointing at the back.



Embroider with black thread the eyebrows. Glue some eyelashes on the eyes.



# **Shoes 2x:**

Using colornr 251.

## The chain3 at the beginning of the round, counts as a double crochet!

**Rnd 01:** Ch11, start in the 4<sup>e</sup> ch from the hook, dc in next 7 st, dc5 in 1, contnue on the other side of the chain, dc in next 7 st, dc4 in 1 ( use the bottom stitch of the starting chain ), close round with slst in top chain (24)

Rnd 02: Ch3, dc in next 7 st, 5x (dc2 in 1), dc in next 7 stk, 4x (dc2 in 1), dc1, close round with slst in top chain

(34)

Rnd 03: Ch1, sc in next 7 st, hdc2 in 1, hdc, 7x (dc2 in 1), hdc, hdc2 in 1, sc in next 15 st, close round with slst in 1<sup>e</sup> stitch. (42)

Rnd 04: Ch1, sc in each stitch, change to *colornr 226*, close round with slst in 1<sup>e</sup> stitch (42)

We're working in continuous rounds.

Rnd 05: Ch1, sc in each *Back loop* (42)

#### We make another sole first!

Crochet another sole using **colornr 406** from round 01 to round 04, **No colorchange!** Place the sole on the cardboard and cut out the exact form of the sole. Make sure it fits nicely.



Place the sole with good side below, against the sole of the shoe. Crochet the two soles together as follow; take the next stitch one the sole AND the first remaining loop of the shoe (see photo), \*slst\*, repeat \*\* to end of round. Close round with a slst in the 1<sup>e</sup> st and **FO**. Do'n forget to put the cardboard in between!!!



Photo is from one of my other patterns, but the principle remains the same.

#### Continue with the shoe

Rnd 06 - 09: sc in each stitch (42)

**Rnd 10:** make some sc untill you reach the middle at the back of the shoe, I needed 40 sc, mark the last stitch as end of round

**Rnd 11:** sc in next 12 st, 9x (sc2tog), sc in next 12 st (33)

**Rnd 12:** sc in next 13 st, 4x (sc2tog), sc in next 12 st (29)

Rnd 13: sc in next 11 st, slst in next 9 st, sc in next 9 st (29)

Continue in rows!

**Row 14:** sc in next 11 st, Ch1, turn (11)

Row 15: reverse single crochet; 20 Rsc, Ch1, turn (20)

**NOTE!!!** If you crochet really tightly, make about 5 – 10 chains more as indicated.

**Row 16:** sc in next 20 st, Ch31, turn (20sc+31ch)

**Row 17:** start in 2<sup>e</sup> stitch from the hook, slst in next 30 st, continue on the shoe; *reverse single crochet*, 20 Rsc, Ch31, turn (30slst+20sc+31ch)

**Row 18:** start in 2<sup>e</sup> stitch from the hook, slst in next 30 st, continue on the shoe; \*slst, Ch1\* x 20 **FO.** 



## **Skirt:**

#### **Underskirt:**

Using colornr 113

Instead of using a chain, we'll use double crochet to start. If you don't know how to do this, please click the link below.. Wendy Rademaker explains it very well.

Leaving tail of 20 cm to start. Double crochet 48. The 3 chains **don't** count as a dc. Close round with slst in the first dc.

Rnd 01: in back loops only, Ch3 (count as first dc), dc2 in same stitch, \*dc3 in each back loop\*, rep \*\* to end of round, close round with slst in top chain (144)

Rnd 02 - 10: Ch3, dc in each st, close round with slst in top chain (144)

Rnd 11: in back loops only, Ch2, hdc in each st, close round with slst in top chain

Rnd 12: \*sc, dc2 in 1, dc3 in 1, dc2 in 1, sc, slst\* rep \*\* to end of round, close round with slst 1e st.

FO.

Rnd 13: using *colornr* 106, in the *remaining loops* of round 11 (see photo), Attach in the middle of the first bow, \*sc, dc2 in 1, trc3 in 1, dc2 in 1, sc, slst\* rep \*\* to end of round, close round with slst 1<sup>e</sup> st.



FO, hide loose ends, do NOT hide the thread of the start round dc.

## **Topskirt:**

Using colornr 106.

**Rnd 01:** Attach with a sc in the **back loop** from the first double crochet (see photo) of the starting row of the underskirt. sc in each **Back loop**, close round with slst 1<sup>e</sup> st. (48)



You can now sew the little gap with the starting thread of the underskirt.

**Rnd 02:** Ch1, sc2 in each stitch, close round with slst 1<sup>e</sup> st.

(96)

**Rnd 03:** Ch1, sc in each stitch, close round with slst 1<sup>e</sup> st.

(96)

Rnd 04: Ch1, sc in each stitch, change to colornr 251, close round with slst 1e st.

(96)

**Rnd 05:** Ch1, sc, sc1 in the round below the last one (see photo), \*sc in next 2 st, sc1 in the round below the last one \*, rep \*\* 30 times more, sc, close round with slst 1 st. (96)



Rnd 06: Ch1, sc in each stitch, change to colornr 106, close round with slst 1e st.

(96)

**Rnd 07:** Ch1, sc in each stitch, close round with slst 1<sup>e</sup> st.

(96)

We're creating bows in the next rounds.

Rnd 08: \*Ch5, skip 5 stitches, sc\*, rep \*\* all around

(16 bows)

**Rnd 09:** slst on the first 3 chains of the bow, \*Ch7, sc1 on the 3<sup>th</sup> ch of the next bow\* rep \*\* 15 more times (16 bows)

**Rnd 10:** slst on the first 4 chains of the bow, \*Ch9, sc1 on the 4<sup>th</sup> ch of the next bow\* rep \*\* 15 more times (16 bows)

**Rnd 11:** Ch1, sc9 in each bow, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st and

(144)

**Rnd 12:** using White, attach in the 1<sup>st</sup> single crochet of the previous bow (this way, the seam will be in the middle of the back again), sc in each stitch, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (144)



**Rnd 13:** Ch1, sc in each stitch, change to *colornr 226*, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (144)

Rnd 14: Ch1, sc in next 4 st, sc1 in the round below the last one, \*sc in next 5 st, sc1 in the round below the last one \*, rep \*\* 22 more times, sc, close round with a slst in the 1st st

(144)

**Rnd 15:** Ch1, sc in each stitch, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st and change to *colornr 106* (144)

**Rnd 16 – 18:** Ch1, sc in each stitch, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (144)

Rnd 19: Ch1, \*slst, Ch1\* rep \*\* to end of round.

(144)

FO, hide all loose ends.

# Foot/leg 2x:

using colornr 172 and closing rounds.

## The Ch3 at the beginning of the round counts as a dc!

**Rnd 01:** Ch11, start in the 4<sup>th</sup> chain from the hook, dc in next 7 st, dc5 in 1, continue on the other side of the chain, dc in next 7 st, dc4 in 1 ( use the chain at the bottom of the start chain ), close round with a slst in the top chain (24)

Rnd 02: Ch3, dc in next 7 st, 5x (dc2 in 1), dc in next 7 st, 4x (dc2 in 1), dc1, close round with a slst in the top chain (34)

Rnd 03: Ch1, sc in next 7 st, hdc2 in 1, hdc, 7x (dc2 in 1), hdc, hdc2 in 1, sc in next 15 st, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (42)

FO.

#### In continuous rounds.

Rnd 04: attach with sc in the back loop in the middle of the back of the sole (I had to couback), sc in each Back loop	nt 5 stitches ( <b>42</b> )
Rnd 05 - 07: sc in each stitch	(42)
<b>Rnd 08:</b> sc in next 13 st, 8x (sc2tog), sc in next 13 st	(34)
<b>Rnd 09:</b> sc in next 12 st, 5x (sc2tog), sc in next 12 st	(29)
<b>Rnd 10:</b> sc in next 10 st, 5x (sc2tog), sc in next 9 st	(24)
Rnd 11: sc in next 10 st, sc2tog, sc, sc2tog, sc in next 9 st	(22)
Rnd 12 - 20: sc in each stitch	(22)

**Put the foot into the shoe and place it on a flat surface.** Now stuff the foot firmly. Cos the shoe is one a flat surface, you won't overfill them and the bottom can't be bulging; Tie the shoelaces in the front.

**Rnd 21:** sc in next 8 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 10 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 2 st (24)

*sc in next 2 st, sc1 with colorchange to nr 251*, mark this stitch as end of round. You should be in the middle of the back. If not, adjust the amount of stitches.

Rnd 22: sc in each stitch (24)

Rnd 23: sc in each Back loop (24)

Continue stuffing.

**Rnd 38:** sc in each stitch, slst in next 2 st (the slipstitches are needed to flatten the round. You only do them on the first leg!).

FO.

Make a second leg, do NOT fasten off. Continue with round 01 of the body, after you made the edge around the legs.

Edge: foot away from you

**Rnd 01:** attach at the back with *colornr* **106** and 1sc in the 1<sup>st</sup> free remaining loop of round 23, (hdc + dc + hdc) in 1, sc, slst, \*sc, (hdc + dc + hdc) in 1, sc, slst\* rep \*\* 4 more times, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st. **FO.** 

Hide all loose ends.



## **Body:**

Using colornr 251

Take the first made leg and count 4 stitches back (=2slst + 2sc back) mark this stitch.

Rnd 01: continue with the leg you didn't fasten off, sc in next 10 st (these stitches won't be counting with the total at the end, Ch2, take the first leg and sc1 in the stitch with the mark (the legs are now joined together) sc in next 23 st on this leg, sc1 on each chainstitch (=2), sc in next 24 st on the second leg, sc1 on each chainstitch (=2), mark the last st as end of round. (52)



Rnd 02: sc in each stitch (52)

**Rnd 03:** \*sc in next 11 st, sc2tog\* x 4 (48)

Rnd 04 - 12: sc in each stitch

(48)

sc, sc1 with color change to colornr 172, mark this stitch as end of round. This will NOT change the amount of stitches.

Rnd 13: sc in each stitch (48)

Take the skirt and place it with the seam at the back and in the middle over the body (also at the back). We join the skirt with the body.

Rnd 14: take the first free loop of the skirt AND the next stitch on the body, and sc1 (see photo), do the same with the next 47 loops and stitches (48)

Rnd 15: sc in each stitch (48)

Keep stuffing.

**Rnd 16:** \*sc in next 6 st, sc2tog\* x 6 (42)

**Rnd 17 – 28:** sc in each stitch (42)

#### Stuff body firmly.

Let's join the arms now to the body.

Take an arm and count 7 stitches forward, mark this stitch. This stitch is the first stitch to use to join the left arm with the body.

Also count 7 stitches forward on the other arm, mark this stitch. This stitch will be the first stitch to join the right arm with the body.

If the arms are not nicely against the body after joining, adjust the stitches back or forwards if necessary.

Rnd 29: sc in next 11 st, push the hook through the marked stitch of the left arm AND the next stitch on

the body (see photo), sc1, repeat with the next 6 stitches, sc in next 14 st, push the hook through the marked stitch of the right arm AND the net stitch on the body, sc1, repeat with the next 6 stitches, sc in next 3 st (42)



## Arms joined with body

Rnd 30: sc in next 11 st, sc in next 8 unworked stitches on the left arm, sc in next 14 st on the body, sc in next 8 unworked stitches on the right arm, sc in next 3 st. (44)

Rnd 31: sc in next 9 st, sc2tog, sc in next 30 st, sc2tog, sc		(42)
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Stuff firmly, especially on the shoulders and the neck.

# Slst in next 2 st and FO leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff neck firmly. Sew the head on to the neck, using round 3 for it. (see photo below)

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**Row 02:** \*sc, sc2 in 1\* rep \*\* to end of row, you'll end with sc, Ch1, turn (37)

Row 03: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn (37)

**Row 04:** sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 13 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next

**Row 05:** sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 6 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 15 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 6 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 5 st, Ch1, turn

(45)

**Row 06:** sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 7 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 17 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 7 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 5 st, Ch1, turn (49)

**Row 07:** sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 8 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 19 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 8 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 5 st, Ch1, turn (53)

**Row 08:** sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 10 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 19 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 10 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 5 st, Ch1, turn (57)

**Row 09:** sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 12 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 19 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 12 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 5 st, Ch1, turn (61)

**Row 10:** sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 14 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 19 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 14 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 5 st, Ch1, turn (65)

**Row 11:** sc in next 5 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 16 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 19 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 16 st, sc2 in 1, sc in next 5 st, Ch1, turn (69)

Row 12: sc in next 6 st, Ch6, skip 18 stitches, sc in next 21 st, Ch6, skip 18 stitches, sc in next 6 st, Ch1, turn (45)

Row 13: sc in each stitch and in each chainstitch, change to colornr 251, Ch1, turn (45)



Row 14: sc in each *front loop*, Ch1, turn (45)

Row 15 - 19: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn (45)

FO.

Using colornr 106.

**Row 01:** attach with a sc in the 1<sup>st</sup> free loop of row 14, sc in each loop, Ch1, turn (45)



In next row we're making chains. Pull the chst tightly.

#### change to hook 2 mm,

Row 02: sc, \*Ch15, skip one stitch, sc\* x 21, sc, Ch8, turn

(21 chainbows)

Row 03: *change to hook 2.5 mm*, sc on the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch of row 19 (see photo), push hook through the bow and sc on the next stitch of row 19, push hook again through the same bow and sc in the next stitch on row 19, \*push hook through the next bow and sc on the next stitch of row 19, push hook again through the same bow and sc in the next stitch on row 19\*, rep \*\* with all bows, Ch1, turn (45)



Row 04: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn				(45)	)
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Row 05: sc in each stitch (45)

Continue in the front upwards.

**Row 01:** sc in the same stitch as previous row, sc in each row end, Ch1, turn (21)

Row 02 - 04: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn, (21)

Row 05: sc in each stitch

FO.

#### Continue on the other side downwards and create buttonholes. Colornr 106

**Row 01:** Attach in the 1<sup>st</sup> topstitch (see photo below), sc in each row ens, Ch1, turn (21)



Row 02: sc in each stitch, Ch1, turn (21)

**Row 03:** sc, Ch3, skip 3 stitches, sc in next 5 st, Ch3, skip 3 stiches, sc in next 5 st, Ch3, skip 3 stitches, sc, Ch1, turn (21)

Row 04: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn (21)

Row 05: sc in each stitch, Ch1 (21)

#### Continue on the bottom of the jacket;

\*1hv, Ch1\* rep \*\* all around the jacket, close round with a slst in the 1st st.

FO.

#### **Sleeves:**

Working in continuous rounds. Using colornr 226.

Rnd 01: attach with a sc at the bottom of the arm, sc in each stitch around, close round with a slst in the 1st st (25)



Rnd 02 - 03: Ch1, sc in each stitch, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (25)

Rnd 04: Ch1, \*sc in next 3 st, sc2tog\* x 5, change to colornr 106, close rnd with a slst in the 1st st (20)

**Rnd 05:** Ch1, sc in each stitch, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (20)

Rnd 06: Ch1, \*slst, Ch1\* rep \*\* to end of round, close round with a slst in the 1st st

FO.

Repeat rounds 01 - 06 for the other sleeve.

Hide loose ends.

Sew buttons.



#### Sun visor:

Using colornr 226.

Working in rows! All even rows are reverse single crochet: so row 2.....4....6

Row 01: Ch28, start in the second ch from the hook, sc in next 27 st, Ch1, turn (27)

Row 02: reverse single crochet, 1 Rsc in each stitch, Ch1, turn (27)

Row 03: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn (27)

Row 04: reverse single crochet, 1 Rsc in each stitch, Ch1, turn (27)

**Row 05:** \*sc2tog\* x 2, sc in next 19 st, \*sc2tog\* x 2, Ch1, turn (23)

Row 06: reverse single crochet, 1 Rsc in each stitch, Ch1, turn	(23)
Row 07: *sc2tog* x 2, sc in next 15 st, *sc2tog* x 2, Ch1, turn	(19)
Row 08: reverse single crochet, 1 Rsc in each stitch, Ch1, turn	(19)
Row 09: *sc2tog* x 2, sc in next 11 st, *sc2tog* x 2, Ch1, turn	(15)
Row 10: reverse single crochet, 1 Rsc in each stitch, Ch1, turn	(15)
Row 11: in back loops only, sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(15)
Row 12: reverse single crochet, *2 Rsc in 1 * x 2, sc in next 11 st, *2 Rsc in 1* x 2, Ch1, turn	(19)
Row 13: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(19)
Row 14: reverse single crochet, *2 Rsc in 1 * x 2, sc in next 15 st, *2 Rsc in 1* x 2, Ch1, turn	(23)
Row 15: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(23)
Row 16: reverse single crochet, *2 Rsc in 1 * x 2, sc in next 19 st, *2 Rsc in 1* x 2, Ch1, turn	(27)
Row 17: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(27)
Row 18: reverse single crochet, 1 Rsc in each stitch, Ch1, turn	(27)
Row 19: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(27)
Row 20: reverse single crochet, 1 Rsc in each stitch, Ch1, turn	(27)
Continue of the second	



Fold in half at the longest side, and join the sides together as follow; take the first stitch + the first loop \*slst, Ch1\* rep \*\* in next 26 stitches

**Row 01:** Give your work a quarter turn and continue on the small sides, join the 2 sides together with 4 sc, Ch1, turn (4)

Row 02: sc in next 4 st, Ch1, turn (4)

**Row 03 - 45:** sc in next 4 st, Ch1, turn (4)

**Note!** It's possible you'll need more or less rows to get all around the head. Adjust the amount of rows if necessary.

Join the short side with the first four rows of the visor as follow (see photo); push hook through both layers + the first stitch of the ribbon \*slst, Ch1\*, rep\*\* for the next 3 stitches, close with a slst in the 1<sup>e</sup> stitch on the longest side.



Join with a slst (through both layers) in the cornerstitch beside the ribbon (see photo), Ch1, \*slst, Ch1\* rep \*\* along the short side downwards, and in the remaining loops of row 11 on the frontside, upwards along the short side untill you reach the ribbon. **FO.** 



# **Handbag:**

Working all rows in the BACK LOOPS only! It will not be indicated in the rows itself.

#### Using colornr 251

<b>Row 01:</b> <i>leaving tail (25 cm)</i> to sew the sides later, Ch26, start in the second ch from the h25 st, Ch1, turn	nook, sc in next (25)
Row 02: sc in each stitch, change to colornr 106, Ch1, turn	(25)
Row 03: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(25)
Row 04: sc in each stitch, change to colornr 226, Ch1, turn	(25)
Row 05: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(25)
Row 06: sc in each stitch, change to colornr 106, Ch1, turn	(25)
Row 07: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(25)
Row 08: sc in each stitch, change to colornr 113, Ch1, turn	(25)
Row 09: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(25)
Row 10: sc in each stitch, change to colornr 106, Ch1, turn	(25)
Row 11: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(25)
Row 12: sc in each stitch, change to colornr 226, Ch1, turn	(25)
Row 13: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn	(25)
Row 14: sc in each stitch, change to colornr 106, Ch1, turn	(25)

Row 15: sc in each stitch, ch1, turn (25)

Row 16: sc in each stitch, change to colornr 251, Ch1, turn (25)

Row 17: sc in each stitch (25)

#### FO, leaving long tail (25 cm).

Sew the sides together with the remaining thread. Hide all loose ends.

Using colornr 106 and closing rounds.

Rnd 01: Join in the middle at the top. Sc in each row end, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (36)



**Rnd 02:** Ch1, sc in each stitch, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (36)

**Rnd 03:** Ch1, sc, Ch2, skip 2 stitches, \*sc, Ch2, skip 2 stitches \* rep \*\* to end of round, close round after the last ch2 with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st

(36)

**Rnd 04:** Ch1, sc in each stitch, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (36)

**Rnd 05:** Ch1, sc2 in each stitch, close round with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> st (72)

Rnd 06 - 07: Ch1, sc in each stitch, close round with a slst in the 1st st

#### FO after round 07.

*In the color of choice;* make a slipknot, join with a sc in the seam on the side (see photo), Ch60, join with a sc on the other side (see photo), Ch1, turn



SIst in each chainstitch, FO.

In the color of choice; Chain 61, start in the second ch from the hook, slst in each ch. FO.



# Final steps:

- 1. Glue the flower on to the shoe.
- 2. Wave the chain around and through the holes in the handbag and tie them in the front
- 3. Place the sun visor on her head. Fold the lid a bit upwards.
