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Size of the finished clover with the suggested yarn is 22 cm. The size may be different depending on the thread used and the gauge.

Hook size 2 mm

4 beads 3 – 5 mm (buttons)

Some decoration for the slippers.

Stuffing

Piece of cardboard for the soles

# Stitches & abbreviations: US terminology

MR – Magic ring

Ch – Chain(stitch)

Slst – slipstitch

Sc – single crochet

Hdc – half double crochet

Dc – double crochet

Tc – treble crochet

FPDC – front post double crochet

BPDC – back post double crochet

Sc2 in 1 – 2 single crochet in one stitch

Sc2tog - double crochet 2 stitches together

Turn

Rnd – round(s)

\*.....\* repeat (rep) between the \*\*

#### (..) at the end of the line, gives the amount of stitches after this row or round.

# Pattern:

# <u>Slippers 2x:</u>

Using Colornr 253.

Rnd 01: Ch6, start in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> stitch from the hook, sc2 in 1, 3sc, sc4 in 1, contin	nue on the other side of the
chain, 3sc, sc2 in 1	(14)
Rnd 02: 1sc, sc2 in 1, 3sc, sc2 in 1, 2sc, sc2 in 1, 3sc, sc2 in 1, 1sc	(18)
<b>Rnd 03:</b> *sc2 in 1* x 2, 5sc, *sc2 in 1* x 4, 5sc, *sc2 in 1* x 2	(26)

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Intermediate step: 2slst, Ch1, turn (you will now crochet 1 row back so that the beautiful side of your work is on top <sup>(2)</sup>)

**Rnd 04:** *back loop only,* sc in each stitch, join with 1slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> single crochet (26)

Fasten off.

Nose of the slipper:

Using Colornr 253.

Row 01: count 7 stitches forward and attach to it with 1sc, 1sc, \*sc2tog\* x 2, 3sc, \*sc2tog\* x 2, 2sc, Ch1, turn (11)



Row 02: sc in each stitch, Ch1, turn	(11)
Row 03: 2sc, sc2tog, 3sc, sc2tog, 2sc, Ch1, turn	(9)
Row 04: sc in each stitch, Ch1, turn	(9)
Row 05: 2sc, sc2tog, 1sc, sc2tog, 2sc	(7)

We crochet further along the row-ends towards the sole.

**Row 06:** 1sc in the same stitch as the last single crochet, 3sc in the row-ends, 11slst on the sole, 4sc in the row-ends, join with 1 sl st on 1st stitch on top.

#### Fasten off.

Using *Colornr 253*: Make another sole starting from rnd 01 to rnd 03. Do NOT fasten off.

Put the sole on a piece of cardboard and round the circumference. Cut out the shape on the inside of your drawing. Cut if necessary more to fit the cardboard on the sole. (photo 1)

Place the sole, right side facing down, against the sole of the slipper. Slst the soles together using each stitch on the sole and each stitch of the remaining loops of the slipper (photo 2). Don't forget to put the cardboard in between the 2 pieces before finishing.



Fasten off. Hide all loose ends. Glue some decoration on top of the slipper.



## <u>Onesíe:</u>

Using Colornr 385.

**Row 01:** Ch 20, start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch from the hook, 2sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 3sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 5sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 3sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 2sc, Ch1, turn (23sc+8Ch)

 Row 02: 3sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 5sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 7sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 5sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 3sc, Ch1, turn
 (31sc+8Ch)

**Row 03:** 4sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 7sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 9sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 7sc, (sc+2ch+sc) in 1 stitch, 4sc, Ch1, turn (39sc+8Ch)

Row 04: 6sc, Ch 6, skip the single crochets, 1sc in next chain space, 11sc, 1sc in next chain space, Ch 6, skip the single crochets, 1sc in next chain space, 5sc, Ch1, turn (25sc+12Ch)

Row 05: sc in each stitch (crochet IN the chainstitch and not in the chain space), Ch1, turn (37)

Row 06: 1sc in each stitch, Ch1, turn

#### Row 07: 6sc, sc2 in 1, 4sc, sc2 in 1, 13sc, sc2 in 1, 4sc, sc2 in 1, 6sc, Ch1, turn

Row 08: 1sc in each stitch, Ch1, turn	(41)
Row 09: 2sc, sc2 in 1, 17sc, sc2 in 1, 17sc, sc2 in 1, 2sc, Ch1, turn	(44)
Row 10: 1sc in each stitch, Ch1, turn	(44)
Row 11: 1sc in each stitch, Ch2, turn	(44)
The chainstitches DO NOT count as first double crochet.	5
Row 12: 1Dc in each stitch, Ch2, turn	(44)

<b>Row 13:</b> 2Dc, *1FPDC, 1BPDC* x 20, 2dc, join with 1slst in the 1 <sup>st</sup> double crochet.	(44)
We now work in continuous rounds.	
Rnd 01: Ch1, start in closing stitch, sc in each stitch	(44)
Rnd 02 – 06: sc in each stitch	(44)
Intermediate step: 1sc.	
We now crochet the left leg.	
Rnd 07: 1sc, mark this stitch as BEGIN of the round, 21sc, Ch3	(22sc+3Ch)
<b>Rnd 08:</b> 1sc on the marked begin stitch, 21sc, 3sc on the chainstitches between the legs, r stitch as end of round.	nark the last <b>(25)</b>

Rnd 22 - 23: Ch2, *1FPDC, 1BPDC* x 10, join with 1slst in the 1 <sup>st</sup> double crochet.	(20)
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#### Fasten off.

#### We now crochet the right leg.

Rnd 07: attach with 1sc on the middle chain between the legs, mark this stitch as BEGIN of round, 1sc on the next chst, 22sc, 1sc on the chain between the legs, mark the last sc as end of round (25)



Rnd 08 – 19: sc in each stitch(25)Rnd 20: \*3sc, sc2tog\* x 5(20)Intermediate step:3sc, 1slst, mark the slst as end of round

Rnd 21: Ch2 (don't counts as dc), begin in same stitch, 1Dc in each stitch, join with 1slst in the 1st double<br/>crochet.(20)

Rnd 22 - 23: Ch2, \*1FPDC, 1BPDC\* x 10, join with 1slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> double crochet. (20)

Fasten off.

## Border and collar:

#### Using Colornr 385.

**Rnd 01:** we now crochet in the row-ends towards the collar as follows; Attach with 1sc in the lower part of the double crochet (see photo), 1sc in the same dc, \*Ch5, 1slst in the side of the sc, 4sc\* x3, Ch5, 1slst in the side of the sc, 1sc, sc3 in 1 on the first stitch of the collar, 17sc, sc3 in 1, 15sc in the row-ends downwards, Ch1, turn (56)

Rnd 02: 39slst, \*1slst IN each chainstitch (=5), 4slst\* x 3, 1hv IN each chainstitch (=5), 2slst

Fasten off.



#### <u>Sleeves:</u>

Using Colornr 385.

Rnd 01: attach with 1sc in the middle under the arm, 15sc



and the second	
<b>Rnd 02:</b> *3sc, sc2 in 1* x 4	(20)
Rnd 03 - 11: sc in each stitch	(20)
Rnd 12: *3sc, sc2tog* x 4	(16)
Rnd 13: *6sc, sc2tog* x 2	(14)

Intermediate step rechterarm: 3sc, 1slst

Intermediate step linkerarm: 2sc, 1slst

Rnd 14: Ch2 (don't counts as dc), begin in same stitch, 1Dc in each stitch, join with 1slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> double crochet. (14)

Rnd 15: Ch2, \*1FPDC, 1BPDC\* x 7, join with 1slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> double crochet. (14)

Fasten off. Do the same with the other sleeve.

Hide all loose ends. Sew the beads on the opposite side of the buttonholes.

Using Colornr 253: make a chain of 101 Ch, start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch from the hook, 1slst in each stitc.

#### Fasten off.

*Hide all loose ends. Thread the chain under the front relief dc.*
